Call to Order at 7:00 PM. Minutes from the November 22nd, 2021 meeting were approved, as written.

Old Business: None

New Business: Jim Bonfiglio, Director of Operations for Casady School presented a proposal for temporary traffic changes during construction at the school. Casady will be undergoing construction from approximately August 2022 through December 2022. This will effect the pick-up and drop-off traffic entering and exiting onto Britton Road. Casady has acquired the former Pool and Spa building directly east and south of Casady and asked that traffic exiting the school be able use both lanes of Nichols Road southbound during the approximate times of 7:20 – 8:15 AM and 2:50 – 3:20 PM to help expedite traffic and reduce congestion on Britton Road. Casady will be closing the gate onto Britton in early June to pave the parking lot and this area will be used for material storage during construction and will not be available for parking or a queue line.

After discussion, the Traffic Commission recommended the following:

- Citizens on Nichols Road be brought into the conversation.
- An officer/ security personnel be used to direct traffic at Britton Road during this time. Traffic turning east onto Britton Road will need to be assisted by the officer.
- Village Public Works should adjust the traffic light at Penn and Britton to accommodate the additional west bound traffic coming from Casady during those times.
- Casady will advise parents of other alternative routes through Casady.
- Mr. Bonfiglio agreed to have three lanes of traffic onto campus from Britton and leave Nichols Road open to two-way traffic unless Britton becomes congested

and if that occurs, then Nichols Road will temporarily become two lanes, one way only southbound.

The Traffic Commission agreed to readdress this issue, if problems arise during next fall.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:10 PM.
